FULLY FUNDED MASTER'S SCHOLARSHIPS EACSP COHORT 4

The EAC Scholarship Programme (EACSP), supported by the East African Community (EAC) and the Federal Republic of Germany and implemented by IUCEA, provides scholarships for eligible Master's studies in an EAC Partner State other than the applicant's country of citizenship.

The Programme aims to develop future leaders and promote regional integration and sustainable development across East Africa.

Dar es Salaam University College of Education (DUCE) is among the participating universities under the KfW-funded EAC Scholarship Programme (EACSP) – Cohort 4, offering the following eligible Master's programmes:

ELIGIBLE DUCE MASTER'S PROGRAMMES:

01	Master of Science in Environmental Biology
02	Master of Science in Industrial Chemistry
03	Master of Science with Education

ELIGIBILITY

01	Eligible applicants: Nationals of Burundi, Democratic Republic of Congo, Kenya, Rwanda, Somalia, South Sudan, Tanzania and Uganda
02	Age: Below 35 years
03	Duration: 2 years
04	Study Location: Applicants must study in an EAC Partner State other than their country of citizenship.
05	Academic qualification: Applicants must have at least a Second-Class Upper Division, Distinction or equivalent Bachelor degree qualification.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- Only complete applications for eligible programmes, submitted before the deadline, in English and in accordance with the application guidelines, shall be considered.
- Applicants must complete both stages of the application process: Apply for admission to an eligible Master's programme at a participating university, and submit a separate application for the EAC Scholarship Programme.
- Applicants must submit all mandatory supporting documents as specified in the Supporting Documents Checklist. Failure to do so will result in the application being deemed incomplete and ineligible for further consideration.
- Applicants applying for more than one programme must submit a separate complete application for each programme applied for.
- Only shortlisted applicants will be contacted.
- Providing false, misleading or incomplete information may result in automatic disqualification from the selection process or withdrawal of a scholarship award.
- IUCEA reserves the right to verify any information and supporting documentation submitted as part of the application process.
- Successful applicants may commence their studies at the earliest available intake, depending on the admission schedules and academic calendars of the respective host universities.
- Submission of an application does not guarantee the award of a scholarship.
- The scholarship opportunity cannot be deferred to a later time or transferred to another person. Failure to take up the opportunity at the time of the award will result in its termination.
